March 2008**

April 2007.

Spent the first month foot patrolling the areas with my newly acquired map book to familiarise myself with my beat areas.

Visited all the businesses within my beat area to make myself known and to pass on details of myself and the job I do.

25/4/07 conducted a community action walk in Davenham which was to utilise members of the community and partner agencies to identify troublesome areas. This was covered by the Guardian

27/4/07 conducted a community action walk in Moulton with partner agencies and members of the community in order to identify troublesome spots in Moulton.
